All students at Whiteford Elementary School are eligible to receive Title I services in reading, math, science and/or social studies at any time throughout the year. Title I is a federally funded program aimed at providing funds to give students additional assistance when needed.

Whiteford provides this assistance through Title I teacher aides helping students. This help may range from helping the student pay closer attention to the teacher during instruction, to working one to one with the student in a troublesome area of learning. When a student is having difficulty with a particular concept or skill or working below grade level, he or she will receive this assistance. Sometimes certain concepts are more difficult to grasp, and at those times, students receive this special assistance. Therefore, students may have Title I help at various times throughout the year.

As a requirement of Title I and also to further help your child through the cooperative effort of home and school, we have developed a “Parent Compact.” Please read this compact and practice the suggestions to help your child toward successful learning.
