Eligibility - What are the standards

- A. Students who fail two or more courses taken during the previous semester will be ineligible for one full semester.
- B. In season bi-weekly eligibility will work as follows:
 - 1. School starts Sept.3
 - 2. Grades will be pulled for the first time on Sept.26-update/warning
 - 3. Grades will be pulled again on Oct.3, if a student has 2 failing grades they will be ineligible for one week Monday-Sunday
 - 4. Students who are ineligible twice during a season will be dismissed from team
- C. Whiteford Athletic Agreement
 - 1. Online on the school website under athletics-resources
 - 2. Code of conduct needs to be signed by student athlete and parent
 - 3. Student athletes here are role models and are held to high standards

Participation Fees

- A. \$100 per sport per season MS/HS
- B. \$250 individual yearly cap
- C. \$450 family cap

Athletic Passes

- A. \$150 Family pass
- B. \$100 Individual pass
- C. \$35 Student pass
- D. \$35 Senior pass

Athletic Trainer

- A. We currently do not have a trainer-our provider was only able to fill 2 of 6 schools
- B. Shortage of trainers due to changes in education requirements
- C. Only one team in our conference will have a trainer this year
- D. Emergency Action Plans posted by all athletic facilities and all paid coaches were required to be CPR certified

Parent/Coach Communication

- A. Appropriate Concerns to discuss with coaches
 - 1. Expectations for your student-athlete during practices and games
 - 2. Ways to help your student-athlete improve and understand their role
 - 3. Academic support and college opportunities
- B. Inappropriate Issues To Discuss With Coaches
 - 1. Playing time- It is often difficult to accept your child not playing as much as you and they had hoped. Remember the coaches see all the athletes in practice everyday and seasons are long, as a student athlete improves in their role and strategy dictates, playing time could increase.

Procedure For Discussing Appropriate Concerns

- A. Student-athlete talks to coach directly
- B. Parent communicates with coach
- C. Parent communicates with athletic director

Discussions are to be avoided immediately following a contest, emotions are high, 24 hour rule.

If a parent feels a coach has acted unprofessionally, they are welcome to contact the AD at any time.
