Safety Drill 10/9

- On Wednesday, October 9th, we will conduct a safety drill at school that entail use of our "Lockout USA" Boot/Lighting system.
- This drill will entail what is called a "teach in place" for students/teachers: meaning there is not an imminent safety threat, but there is need for clear hallways and privacy throughout the school.
- A "teach in place" is most often used for student/staff medical emergencies, but it can also be employed when there are potential safety concerns that allow for instruction to continue, but may prohibit movement throughout the building/grounds.
- Please do speak to your student about the seriousness of safety drills in school. If a student attempts to enter the building during any sort of "lockdown" or "teach in place," they would notice the flashing lights in the hallways and return to their vehicles until the conclusion of the situation/drill. The same goes for parents/visitors during drills.
