Elementary Cell Phone/Device Policy

- All cell phones, smart watches or other communication devices are allowed to be brought to school.
- **BUT**, while at school these devices need to be powered off and stored out of sight.
- From the Whiteford Elementary Handbook pg. 23
 - “Students may possess wireless communication devices (WCDs) in school, on school property, during after school activities (e.g. extra-curricular activities) and at school-related functions, provided that during school hours the WCDs are powered completely off (i.e., not just placed into vibrate or silent mode) and stored out of sight.”
 - “Violations of this policy may result in disciplinary action and/or confiscation of the WCD.”

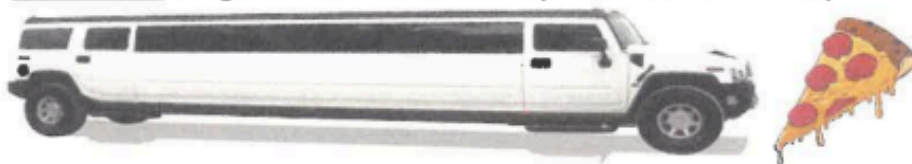

WHAT WE'VE ACCOMPLISHED

In only 3 short months of planning, the committee hosted the first Whiteford Fall Festival in 2021. Since then, there have been 3 festivals and a dog walk— raising over \$100,000 for the playground project. In September of 2024, Phase I of the playground will be installed at Stoneco park.

With nearly 10,000 attendees in 2023, our festival included a 300+ car and tractor show; live entertainment; silent auction; several food trucks; 100 vendor and craft booths; a kids play zone including bounce houses, face painting & a fire breathing juggler; a visit from Monroe County's Mounted Police and K9 Units, and so much more!
